CITY COUNCIL, SPECIAL SESSION, June 22, 2020**

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Councilperson Sarah Burge moved to go into Executive Session at 7:05 pm, seconded by Councilperson Sherry Johnson. Motion carried, vote of 5 yes.

NEW BUSINESS:

- a) Discussion and Approval of Aaron Foster Water Plant Operator pay raise effective July 1, 2020.
 - Councilperson Sarah Burge moved to increase Aaron Foster's pay \$100 more per month effective July 1, 2020, seconded by Councilperson Kenny Richmond. Motion carried, vote of 5 yes

OLD BUSINESS:

- a) Discussion and Approval of Hiring Chad Bromelow to fulfill the Cops Grant.
 - Councilperson Sarah Burge moved to hire Chad Bromelow to fulfill Cops Grant with starting pay of \$16.00/hr. after 6 months' probation pay of \$17.00/hr. and after certification pay of \$18.00/hr. with tentative start date of July 6, 2020, seconded by Councilperson Sherry Johnson. Motion carried, vote of 5 yes.

Councilperson Greg Galentine turned in his resignation for Ward 3, effective June 30, 2020; so, he can take his position as elected Mayor on July 1, 2020.
