The SSVF Program is designed to improve the housing stability of very low-income veteran families by assisting with the transition from homelessness to permanent housing and preventing at-risk families from becoming homeless.


Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a veteran or a member of a family in which the head of household, or the spouse of the head of household is a veteran.
- Very low income. Household income can not exceed 50% of the area median income.
- Occupying permanent housing in one of three categories:
 - 1. Residing in permanent housing.
 - 2. Homeless and scheduled to become a resident of permanent housing within 90 days.
 - Has exited permanent housing within the previous 90 days to seek other housing that is responsive to the very low income veteran family's needs and preferences.
