The (CITY OF CAMERON WATER DEPARTMENT PWSD #3302603) with the assistance of Marshall County Emergency Management are providing a Wireless Emergency Notification System (WENS) for the residents of the county. By signing up you will receive alerts and public service announcements in the event of a water break or outage. Along with any emergency or weather warnings in your area. An alert may be sent to the phone or phones you provide and/or your email address.

This is a free service provided by the county; however, normal message fees may apply. To receive text messages to your cell phone, your phone must have text messaging capabilities.

There are two ways to register, simply text "MarshallWVAlerts" to 69310, you will be provided with a registration page link.
